Comp Plan Committee Seeks Input from Morley, Pyrites Residents

Residents of the hamlets of Morley and Pyrites are invited to share their visions for their communities at two upcoming public outreach sessions hosted by members of the Canton Comprehensive Plan Committee.

On Wednesday, April 18, at 6:30 p.m., Town Councilors Jim Smith and Tim Danehy will host a public discussion at the Morley Bingo Hall; on Thursday, April 19, at 6:30 p.m., Village Trustee Sean O'Brien and Town Councilor Danehy will welcome residents for discussion at the Pyrites Fire Hall.

The Comprehensive Plan Committee is working with a consulting team to chart a "vision for the future and a blueprint-for-change." They are looking for residents' thoughts, ideas, and concerns related to community growth, land use, planning, economic development, infrastructure, and more.
